**Conditions:** The Championship will be decided by strokes over three rounds of 18 holes each, in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews, with the Czech Golf Federation Hard Card 2014 and with the Supplementary Local Rules as approved by the Championship Committee.  
After the second round of the Championship there will be a cut. Only the best scores of 45 men and 15 ladies and those tying will qualify for the final round. In the event of a tie after three rounds of the Championship, the winner will be decided by a sudden death play-off on holes determined by the Championship Committee before the Championship commences. The Play-off will take place immediately after the last players have finished their round.  
Ties for other prizes will be decided by the lowest score for the last 18, 9, 6, 3 and 1 hole.

**Eligibility:** Amateur players born in 1979 or earlier who are members of an affiliated Czech or foreign golf club and have an exact handicap within the announced HCP limits are eligible to compete in the Championship. Handicaps must be certified by their home club or national golf federation.

**Handicap limits:** Amateurs 11,0  
Ladies 18,0  
(Handicaps better than Scratch should be indicated as “plus”)  
If there are more than 144 entries (108 amateurs, 36 ladies), amateurs and ladies with the highest handicaps will be balloted out.

- Entry fee:** 1500,- CZK in cash (or equivalent in EUR 60,- in cash)  
Must be paid upon registration, Wednesday May 21<sup>st</sup>, 2014 until 5 p.m.  
Entry fee includes water and fruit on the golf course for players during their Championship rounds.  
Entry fee does not include any practice round.
- Official practice round:** Wednesday May 21<sup>st</sup>, 2014  
Special discounted rate for the Championship players - 1100,- CZK
- Closing date for entries:** **Wednesday May 14<sup>th</sup>**, 2014 at noon

- Specific Conditions:** Please note that in this Championship the following Specimen Conditions of Competition and Local Rules as specified in the Appendix I of the Rules of Golf are in effect:
- **List of Conforming Driver Heads**
  - **List of Conforming Golf Balls**
  - **Transportation** (riding on any form of transportation is prohibited)
  - **Distance-Measuring Devices** (use of DMDs is allowed)
- Dress code:** Only shoes with soft spikes are allowed, appropriate golfing attire, **jeans are strictly prohibited!**
