Lithuanian 30+ & Senior Open Championship 2016

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

Organizers

Lithuanian Golf Federation European Centre golf club

Date

Practice day: 09.01 (thursday) 1st round: 09.02 (friday) 2nd round: 09.03 (saturday) 3rd round: 09.04 (sunday)

Form of play

Stroke play over 3 rounds of 18 holes each day.

Eligibility of competitors

All competitors must be:

- a) amateur golfers;
- b) golfers whose exact active handicap does not exceed:

men: 28.0*ladies: 35.9*

The handicap must be certified by the secretary of the national golf authority or entrant's home club and must have been valid on the date of entry.

- * Players can register to the championship with a higher handicap as well. Waiting list will be created for them. Participants from the waiting list will be added to championship if participants with appropriate handicap won't exceed entries limit. Players from the waiting list will be informed about possibility to participate in the championship not earlier than 4th of July.
- c) at least 30 years old on first championship day 2nd of September

Number of competitors

144 competitors (120 men and 24 ladies) shall be eligible to compete. If ladies number will not exceed 24, then men entries will be added. If the number of entries exceeds 144, places in the starting field will be decided by lower handicap. Unsuccessful entrants shall be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently

occur.

Cut

The 72 lowest scores (60 men and 12 ladies) after 36 holes including ties shall qualify for the 3rd (final) round. The Committee is authorised to alter the cut in the event of a smaller entry.

Decision of ties

In the event of a tie for first place after three rounds, the winner shall be decided by a sudden death playoff by stroke play over 10th, 11th 18th hole.

In case of a tie for the silver or bronze medal, the places will be decided on the basis of scores recorded for the final 18, 9, 6, 3 holes or last hole, in that order. If a tie still exists, an 18- hole count-back will be used on the second and then first round, if necessary.

Start*

There will be morning and afternoon starts during first two days from 1st and 10th holes.

Morning start 9:00

Afternoon start 13:00

There will be start from the 1st hole at 8:00 during 3rd (final) day.

*Championship committee can modify start list if number of players is lower than determined.

Rules

The Championship will be played in accordance with the "R&A Rules limited" confirmed by USGA (2016-2019); LGF "Hard card" 2016 and local rules
